



## Code of Conduct for Players

All players are required to agree to and sign the following Code of Conduct in order to participate in JFA.

**ZERO TOLERANCE:** Any player who conducts themselves in a manner found to be detrimental to the welfare of the JFA League may be removed from participating in this organization temporarily or permanently.

- I will encourage good sportsmanship from fellow players, coaches, officials and parents at every game and practice by demonstrating good sportsmanship.
- I will attend every practice and game that I can, and will notify my coach if I cannot. I will be on time for practices, games and will be in proper uniform.
- I will do my best to listen and learn from the coaches.
- I will treat my coaches, other players, officials and fans with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or abilities, and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- I will learn the rules of the game.
- I will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, league official or any other attendee.
- I will not engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety, or well being of a coach, parent, player, participant, league official or any other attendee.
- I will not engage in the use of profanity while attending or participating in a youth sports event.
- I will not engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, league official or any other attendee.
- I will not initiate a fight or scuffle with any coach, parent, player, participant, league official or any other attendee.
- I will remember that sports are an opportunity to learn and have fun.

## Code of Conduct for Parents

*All JFA Parents/Guardians are required to agree to and sign the following Code of Conduct in order to participate in the JFA.*

***ZERO TOLERANCE: Any parent/guardian who conducts themselves in a manner found to be detrimental to the welfare of JFA League may be removed from participating in this organization temporarily or permanently.***

- I will enjoy my child's opportunity to experience the benefits of sport.
- I will trust in my child's ability to have fun as well as to perform and achieve excellence on her own.
- I will help my child to learn the right lessons from winning and losing and from individual accomplishments and mistakes.
- I will respect my child's teammates and fellow parents as well as the players, parents, and coaches from opposing teams.
- I will avoid saying or doing anything which will hurt, degrade or insult any player, parents and coaches. I will give only encouragement and applaud only positive accomplishments whether for my child, her teammates, their opponents or the officials.
- I will respect my child's coach and support his/her efforts. I will refrain from criticizing the job done by the coaching staff.
- I will follow the 24 hour rule. When I have an issue which needs to be discussed with a coach, I agree to wait 24 hours after an event before contacting that coach in person, by phone, or by email.
- I will not instruct from the sidelines unless asked to by the coach.
- I will insure that my child will attend all games and practices and, when not possible, I agree to inform the coach in advance. I will insure that my child will wear the proper uniform provided by their team.
- I will respect all facilities made available so my child can play games and practice her sport.
- I will respect the officials and their authority during games.
- I will never demonstrate threatening or abusive behavior or use foul language.
- I will be responsible to report to JFA any perceived misconduct by coach, player, parent, or official so it can be dealt with in the appropriate manner.
